



Mitchell's Glen - Private Tour Only with Green Lake Conservancy

ECOTOURISM ITINERARY

2 nights - 3 days

DAY 1

1. 9am - Arrive at Sunset Park (GL) and meet local conservancy guide. Tour of Mitchell's Glen or Norwegian Bay, discussing the formation of Green Lake, flora, fauna and the work of the Green Lake Conservancy.
2. 12 noon - Arrive at Boerson's farm. Tour of farm and introduction to sustainable farming plus Farm to Fork concept. Lunch at farm with seasonal products.
3. 2pm - Return/Check into hotel (Comfort Inn/Heidel House/Green Lake Conf.Center)
4. 6pm - Dinner at local restaurant: 680 North (GL), J's BBQ (Ripon), Langford's Pub (GLCC or GLCC Dining Hall).

DAY 2

1. 7am - Arrive at Sunnyside Conservancy (GL) and meet local conservancy guide for birdwatching and nature walk. Introduction to resident and migrant birds, invasive species, native species, prairies and Savannah Oak.
2. 9am - Breakfast or morning snack at Mr. & Mrs. P's (Ripon)
3. 10:30am - Guided walk at one:
 - a. South Woods (Ripon)
 - b. Green Lake Conference Center (GL)
 - c. Mascoutin State Valley Trail (Rush Lake section). Biking available* (Berlin/Ripon)

4. 12 noon – Wine tasting with lunch at Vines & Rushes Winery, or lunch at the Treasury Restaurant with locally harvested products (both in Ripon)

DAY 3

1. 8am - Breakfast at hotel
2. 9:30am - Outdoor Fun (select one):
 - a. White River Marsh guided visit (walk) covering flora, fauna & Whooping Crane conservation project.
 - b. Tour of Green Lake aboard vessel (Escapade HH).
 - c. Fox of the River Voyageur Canoe Tour(Princeton).
 - d. Guided Walk through the Green Lake Conference Center
3. Lunch at Once in a Blue Moon (Princeton), Goose Blind (Green Lake) or Knuth Brewing Company (Ripon)

4. End of Tour
