Day 1

Fun is around every corner at **Busy Barns Adventure Farm**! Interact with the animals, take a hay ride, “get lost” in a corn maze, and watch farm demonstrations. Busy Barns provides a unique hands-on experience where people of all ages can play and learn!

Next stop is **Old World Wisconsin**. Return to Wisconsin of the late 19th century, when waves of immigrants came to America’s heartland in search of a better life. Immerse yourself in Wisconsin’s rich history, while costumed historians act out life in the 1870s at this outdoor living history museum.

It’s time for lunch, and you’ve got choices! Grab a bite at **The Elegant Farmer**, where you will enjoy a homemade lunch along with a slice of their award-winning Apple Pie Baked in a Paper Bag. After lunch, you’ll have some free time to look through the deli, bakery, and market for Wisconsin meats and cheeses and other treats to take home.

OR

Get the freshest lunch you’ll ever have - with the “Hook & Cook” at **Rushing Waters Fisheries**. After a quick tour of this expansive trout farm, they’ll set you up with poles & bait. Head to one of many ponds on-site for easy fishing. Once you’ve hooked your lunch, take it up to the restaurant for the chefs to prepare for you. Before you know it, that fish you just hooked is cooked and on your plate!

After a delicious lunch, learn about the natural way of growing at **Moon Star Farm**. On your tour, you will experience The Garden & Pasture Walk, Mixed Species Grazing, a Soap Making Demonstration, Goat Milking Demonstration, and Herding with Border Collies.

Last stop of the day is **Royal Oak Farm Orchard** where you can pick your own seasonal fruit. This large country farm offers dining and shopping, in addition to their expansive orchard. Your group will take a wagon tour through the orchard with time to pick some apples to take home. Then, enjoy coffee and apple cider donuts back at the barn. Feeling adventurous? Wind your way through the country’s FIRST apple tree maze! Head back to the hotel after a successful day of farm fun.

Day 2

Start your second day with a **Barn Quilt Tour** through Walworth County. A step-on guide will lead the way and point out some of the area's unique Barn Quilts. Hear about the history of these farms and the significance of their barn quilts, all from the comfort of your bus.



Next, you'll get off the bus to stretch your legs and visit with some of the cutest creatures around in the Baby Animals Barn at **Animal Gardens**. After a hayride around the property, head indoors for the famous Bird Show, featuring Echo the talking parrot!



After lunch at an area restaurant, it's back to the great outdoors for a different type of farm - a perennial farm. **Northwind Perennial Farm** features several beautifully landscaped gardens for your group to meander through. Find unique gifts and home decor inside their antique barn, and peruse through their plants available for purchase.

Your final stop on this two-day tour is **Pearce's Farm Stand** in Walworth. In addition to an expansive collection of baked goods, fresh produce, and local honey & cheese, they offer demonstrations, farm tours, box lunches, and seasonal haunted attractions. Pick up some produce before heading home, or stay for a wagon ride and culinary demonstration, complete with samples and recipe to take home.
