## MARINE SANCTUARY OF LAKE MICHIGAN

### Start Your Day: **Learning about the Marine Sanctuary**

- Highlights and protects 37 shipwrecks that have sunk in Lake Michigan. Museum is currently underwater, however, some artifacts and archeological findings are showcased at the Maritime Museum in an exhibit.

### Before Lunch: **Wisconsin Maritime Museum**

- The Midwest's Largest Smithsonian Maritime Museum where you can tour the nation's most completely restored WWII submarine, USS Cobia. Discover a both hands on and learning exhibits throughout the museum. There is a unique collection of model ships and boats, an operating steam engine, displays of historic vessels and marine engines.

### Lunch

- Enjoy a themed lunch in the Judge's Chamber at the **Courthouse Pub**; or a daily sandwich special at the **Harborside Restaurant**.

### Afternoon: **West of the Lake Gardens**

- Walk the 6 acre estate of the lake Ruth and John West created in 1934 and features a rose garden, Japanese garden, sunken and formal gardens with more than 900 feet of herbaceous borders with color annuals along the coast of Lake Michigan.

### Afternoon continued: **Roger Street Fishing Village**

- Discover tales of courageous seafarers and ill-fated schooners through old mariners' tales of seafaring and survival. Learn about our French-Canadian history and heritage.
