DAY ONE

Geneva Lake Luncheon Cruise – Relax and enjoy the scenic beauty of Geneva Lake as you cruise around the entire lake and are served a delicious sit-down meal aboard Lake Geneva Cruise Line's Grand Belle. Enjoy a narrated historical tour as you circle the lake, and soak in the million-dollar views of mansions and estates built by famous families like the Wrigleys, Maytags, and Schwinn's. The luncheon cruise is 2 ¼ hours, departing at 11:30am and running May through October.

Black Point Estate & Gardens Tour – Step back in time at the 1888 Victorian summer retreat of Chicago beer baron, Conrad Seipp. Considered one of the finest examples of period architecture in the Midwest, and one of the oldest homes in Lake Geneva, the estate spans eight acres and 620 feet of shoreline. The jewel of the experience is your 90-minute tour of the first two floors of the Queen Anne-style mansion which include 20 rooms, all filled with original, period furnishings. Tour departs from The Riviera/Lake Geneva Cruise Line dock via bus with Black Point docent aboard.

Dinner at The Fireside Theatre – Since 1964, The Fireside Dinner Theatre in Fort Atkinson, has been the premiere entertainment destination in the Midwest featuring Broadway-quality musical productions with professional staff and state-of-the-art sound and lighting. The 1,000-seat restaurant and 665-seat theatre-in-the-round offer superb group dining options and boutique shops in a one-of-a-kind setting. Motorcoach groups of 18+ are treated to step-on greetings, group leader and driver perks, and more.

DAY TWO

Geneva Lake Museum – Catch a glimpse of what the City of Lake Geneva and Geneva Lake were like during the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Peek into historical homes and stores, a blacksmith shop, a firehouse, and other places along our "Main Street," and see everyday artifacts of a time gone by, including furniture, clothing, and machines, plus a stagecoach, and nautical vessels. Also enjoy the new exhibit, "The Wizard of Lake Geneva", highlighting Lake Geneva's legacy as the birthplace of the world-famous fantasy game, Dungeons & Dragons.

Lunch at Lake City Social – Lake City Social is in the heart of bustling Downtown Lake Geneva overlooking Flat Iron Park and Geneva Lake. Featuring burgers, salads, ribs, pasta, seafood, and steaks along with some unique appetizers, the expansive dining room and private spaces are ideal for groups.

- OR - Lunch at Pier 290 – Minutes from Yerkes Observatory in Williams Bay, Pier 290 offers casual American fare from fresh salads to delectable seafood and grilled steaks with amazing lake views. Choose from lakeside dining both inside the nautical-inspired dining room as well as the outdoor patio under covered canopies.

Yerkes Observatory – This 1897 observatory is known as the birthplace of modern astrophysics and has been home and school to notable astronomers, Nobel prize winners, and renowned scientists. During the hour-and-a-half tour, your guide will share the history and architecture of Yerkes, a close encounter with the world's largest refracting telescope, and the ongoing restoration and preservation of this iconic landmark. Currently, all tours are walking tours both inside the Observatory and outdoors through the historic Olmsted-designed landscape.

Dinner at East Troy Electric Railroad – Enjoy a 14-mile ride on historic trolleys or interurban cars with a stop at the popular Elegant Farmer store and deli. Round trips depart from the East Troy Depot & Museum and travel to Indianhead Park in Mukwonago. Experience the romance of dining aboard award-winning art deco railroad cars with three- and four-course dinner excursions. Meticulously restored coaches of the Chicago South Shore & South Bend Railroad serve as your dining room.

- OR -

Tristan Crist Magic Theatre – Fun for all ages and home to award-winning illusionist Tristan Crist, this must-see show includes Vegas-style magic, comedy, and mind-blowing illusions. This show is named Lake Geneva's #1 Thing To Do on TripAdvisor and is open year-round with new acts added each year. The 90-minute professionally produced show can be scheduled to fit your group's ideal timeline, and the tour operator and bus driver receive a free show ticket.

Dinner at The Getaway on Lake Como – This historic gem is located at The French Country Inn on beautiful Lake Como, just a few minutes from Downtown Lake Geneva. Enjoy fine dining, a cozy atmosphere, and scenic lake views. This property has a fascinating history as a former hideaway for notorious gangsters including "Scarface" Capone, George "Bugs" Moran, Jack "Machine Gun" McGurn, and John Dillinger.
