NATIONAL RAILROAD MUSEUM

“Highlights of the Rails”

Step aboard historic locomotives—including General Dwight D. Eisenhower’s World War II train—and explore exhibits celebrating the golden age of rail travel. Discover the history, culture, and innovation that powered a nation as you walk among the iron giants of America’s past.

Signature Experience: Enjoy admission, a guided tour (available as a highlights or full experience), and a seasonal train ride (May–October). Optional “Hobo Lunches” can be added for \$16 per meal. Recommended Duration: 2 hours (allow extra time if dining)

Signature Experience: Enjoy a self-guided visit through 30,000 square feet of exhibits, or opt for the guided “100-Story Tour” led by a longtime volunteer who brings the history behind each car to life.

GREEN BAY BOTANICAL GARDEN

“Herbal Adventure Experience”

NATIONAL SHRINE OF OUR LADY CHAMPION

Begin your day at this serene rural sanctuary, a place of prayer, peace, and pilgrimage since 1859. Located amid Wisconsin's quiet countryside, the National Shrine of Our Lady of Champion marks the site of the only Marian apparition in the United States approved by the Catholic Church.

Learn the inspiring story of Adele Brise, a young Belgian immigrant whose encounter with the Blessed Virgin Mary transformed this humble location into a place of enduring faith. Stroll through the tranquil grounds, explore the chapel and oratory built on the site of the apparition, and visit the small museum chronicling more than 160 years of answered prayers and pilgrim devotion.



PARALLEL 44 VINEYARD & WINERY

"Winemaker's Tour"

Journey to the heart of Wisconsin wine country and experience the art of winemaking from ground to glass.
