Enjoy a tour through 20 acres of scenic walkways that wind their way through picturesque bridges, an ornate gazebo, and heavenly-scented flower gardens.



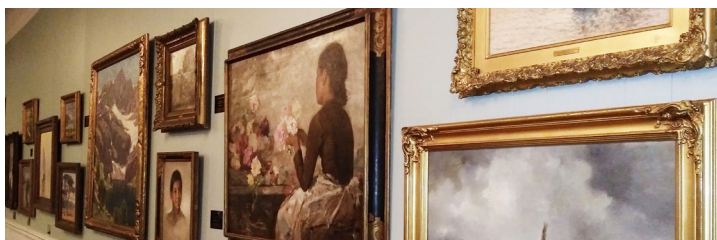
Local Wineries & Breweries

Interested in Wisconsin's brewing heritage, or the state's growing wine scene? Treat your group to guided beer flight tastings and themed trivia, or sip your way through area wineries. Groups can choose one experience or split between breweries and wineries to enjoy the best of both worlds.



Rock County Historical Society & Lincoln-Tallman House

Tour the **Lincoln-Tallman House**, an Italian villa style mansion where Abraham Lincoln was a guest in 1859. Today, the home, located on the grounds of the Rock County Historical Society (RCHS), has been restored and still houses 75% of the original furnishings from the Tallman Family. Also located on the RCHS grounds is the **RCHS Visitor Center**. It offers exhibit galleries that feature Pauline Pottery and Pickard China and Parker Pen, as well as rotating exhibits celebrating the history and heritage of Rock County and a gift shop. The RCHS grounds offer a variety of options for group activities.



Janesville's Galleries

Soak in the arts at any of Janesville's galleries & exhibits: Hedberg Public Library, Janesville Performing Arts Center, Rock County Historical Society, & the Woman's Club Gallery.

Janesville Performing Arts Center

The Center's 637-seat theatre is located in the historic Janesville High School/Marshall Junior High School building in downtown Janesville. JPAC offers performances of live music, theater, comedy, improv, dance, and more.



K & W Greenery

Tour this nearly 2 acre indoor greenhouse growing operation and a nursery that is widely considered one of southern Wisconsin's finest. Take a behind the scenes tour, shop their extensive gift shop, learn during a class or create something special to take home with you.



Glass Garden

Glass Garden teaches glass art classes including private parties, perfect for team building or just for fun. They also offer a large array of finished glass art, including stained glass panels, jewelry, and other unique gifts.



Rock Aqua Jays Water Ski Show

Enjoy a performance by the most successful water ski show team in the world! They perform free water ski shows most Sunday and Wednesday evenings from Memorial Day through Labor Day weekend.



Skelly's Farm Market

Visit a produce-only farm and learn about its history! They are best known for providing the area with fresh strawberries, sweet corn, and pumpkins but they also offer a Sunflower Experience (mid-July to mid-August) and Corn Maze & Fall Festival (September - October). Visit their gift shop and enjoy a sweet treat from their bakery. Tours available June - October. Step-on guided tours are available June - October.



Comedy Cabin

Comedy Cabin hosts live comedy shows with cabaret-style seating and a full bar. They host new comedians each week, with performances typically taking place Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evenings.
